

## TAX NOTICES

The tax notices will be mailed approximately mid May 2013.

**Please remember to fill out the back portion of the notice to claim your Home Owner's Grant** and bring it into the Village Office. The property tax deadline is Tuesday, July 2, 2013. Payments must be received by 4:00 pm on July 2<sup>nd</sup> to avoid a 10% penalty.

\*Note: all items must be sorted (burnable, metals, lawn debris – **no kitchen refuse please**) and placed at the curb or property line.

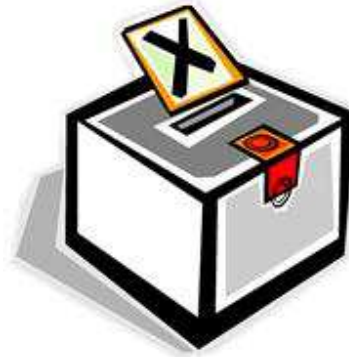

The plumbing and electrical rough-ins is completed and insulation and drywall are now under way. There is lots of work to be completed once the drywall is completed later this month, all of the interior fixtures to be installed, painted, trim counters and more.
