2013 Is 20th year of continuously service on council.

Involved with health care issues from the beginning, appointed to QCI Healthcare Society, Community Health Council, involved in the turnover of the military hospital to civilian operations and the development of current hospital and assisted living units.

Appointed as the Village of Masset representative to the SQCRD in 2001 and has been the chair of the Regional District from 2004 to present.

Other boards, Northern Development Regional Advisory Committee, Northwest Regional Hospital District, GMDC, Economic Development Commission, MIEDs.
