Since its humble beginnings 33 years ago, when Terry Fox ran the equivalent of one marathon—26 miles, or 42 km—each day and every day for 143 days, the annual Terry Fox Run has evolved to become one of the largest single-day fundraising events for cancer research in the world.

**Registration:** Masset Village Office from 11-11:30am – Run starts at 11:30am.

Walk, Run, Bike, Roller blade for 1km–5km–10km. There will be water stations at the 5km and 10 km turn around station.
