This past Sunday, 14<sup>th</sup> September approximately 69 participants turned out to Support Terry’s dream...

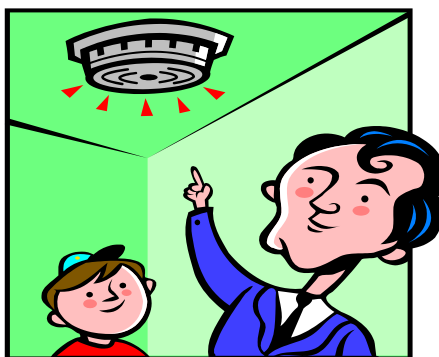
